THINK ABOUT IT

Based on last week's message, where have you decided to serve? Share it with the group.

MAIN GROWTH GROUP SCRIPTURE

The end of all things is near. Therefore be clear minded and self-controlled so that you can pray. Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms. If anyone speaks, he should do it as one speaking the very words of God. If anyone serves, he should do it with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. DISCOVERY QUESTIONS

- The Bible clearly shows that we need each other. Why do you think there is such an emphasis on community in the scriptures?
- (Read the Verse Below) Connecting in community helps you to nurture your important relationships. How can you nurture the current relationships in your life?
 - ...the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow. Colossians 2:19 (NIV)
- (Read the Verse Below) It's important to restore the relationships in your life that are broken. Why is it sometimes difficult to restore broken relationships?
 - Do not repay anyone evil for evil...If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. Romans 12:17-18 (NIV)
- Think about your own relationships (family, neighbors, friends, etc.). Identify one broken relationship that you will begin restoring this week. Discuss this with the group.
- (Read the Verse Below) Connecting in community will help you sever harmful relationships. Why is it sometimes easy to become complacent with unhealthy relationships? What do you think God desires for the relationships in your life?

He who walks with the wise grows wise, but a companion of fools suffers harm. **Proverbs 13:20 (NIV)**

(Read the Verse Below) The Bible cautions us about being connected to wicked people.
 What is the danger in being connected with those who are doing wrong?

Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness?

2 Corinthians 6:14 (NIV)

• (Read the Verse Below) God wants to have a relationship with you. What can you do to nurture your relationship with God?

I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters, says the LORD Almighty." 2 Corinthians 6:18 (NKJV)

LIFE APPLICATION

Biblical community means that you are choosing to be in relationship with a <u>church</u>, <u>small</u> <u>group</u>, <u>team</u>, and <u>God</u>. Pick one of these four areas where you do not have a strong relationship. Next, get suggestions from the group on how you can nurture that relationship.
