- (Read the Verse Below) It is important that we seek God's direction in life. In what area are you currently seeking God's direction?

*Good planning and hard work lead to prosperity... Proverbs 21:5 (NLT)*

- (Read the Verse Below) When is your specific prayer time? How often do you pray for God's guidance and direction?

*The Lord is pleased when good men pray. Proverbs 15:8 (GN)*

- (Read the Verse Below) Describe a time in your life where you thought about a situation first, instead of making a poor choice.

*Wise people think before they act; fools don't—and even brag about their foolishness. Proverbs 13:16 (NLT)*

- It's important to sharpen your skills. In the education field, it is often stated that we should be a lifelong learner. What are you currently learning to help you sharpen your skills?
- When you honor God He will bless you. Discuss the verse below in the group.

*Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. Then he will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with good wine. Proverbs 3:9-10 (NLT)*

- (Read the Verses on the Next Page) Don't give up! It's important that we "stay with it" if we want to see success in life. How can you be more diligent in your work?

*The hand of the diligent will rule, but the slack hand will be put to forced labor. Proverbs 12:24 (NASB)*

*The plans of the diligent lead to profit as surely as haste leads to poverty. Proverbs 21:5 (NIV)*
